Egyptian-Japanese Education Initiative (EJEP)

Supplementary call for the 2018/2019 summer program

Within the framework of the Egypt-Japan Education Partnership (EJEP), the Cultural Affairs and Missions (Central Department of Missions) are receiving applications for one-month summer program for undergraduate students.

How to apply

Interested candidates can apply electronically through the website of the Cultural Affairs and Missions Sector www.mohe-casm.edu.eg from 7/4/2019 until 20/4/2019 attaching photocopy of all the required documents electronically. Also the hard copy of all the documents should be delivered to Central Department of Missions ("Mogama'a El Tahrir 7th floor, Cairo") as follows:

- A certified enrollment statement from the University to verify that the student is in the second or third grade (since joining the university).
- A certificate with the estimates of previous years in the first undergraduate stage of progress shows that the student's assessment is not less than 3.2 or very good or 80%.
- Certificate of postponement or exemption from military service.
- A birth certificate to verify that applicant is not older than the age limit of 22 years on the date of the announcement.
- Approval of the home university (approval of the Vice President for Students Affairs).

Area of specializations

The summer program is positioned as an entry level cultural experience for students who are interested to study in Japan in the future. All specializations are welcome.

Selection process

- ❖ All applications will be reviewed based on the essay written in English (summary, motivation and future plan). It is important for students to fully explain their candidacy.
- ❖ Selected students will be invited to an interview in English to confirm the language level.
- ❖ Final result will be communicated to the students within three weeks from the interview.

Eligibility

- The age should not exceed 22 years at the date of the announcement.
- The student should be in the second or third year of the university in a public Egyptian university.
- The students GPA should be 3.2 or very good or 80% in previous years of study.
- The male students should submit a certificate to verify postponement or exemption of military service.
